SARAH HANSSON, a young half-Trinidadian singer is set to make her name on the local music scene with her new groovy song, Never Knew.

From Gothenburg, Sweden, Hansson is in T&T promoting her new soca/pop musical combination called Caripop. To get an idea of what she sounds like, you can compare her to local band Kes, whose musical style is also referred to as Caripop or crazy Caribbean.

Hansson described her music as soft pop vocals mixed with sweet, Caribbean rhythms. And though she may not be as popular in T&T as her male counterparts who share her signature sound, Hansson said she is more than excited to bring her music to T&T, which she considers her second home.

Born to a Trinidadian mother and a Swedish father, Hansson has been back and forth between the two countries since she was a child. On the soca scene, she has been a back-up vocalist for calypsonian Crazy when he performs in Sweden.

Her song, Never Knew is composed by Hansson who arranged it together with her father, Lars Hansson and Bjorn Hansson, both of the band Soca Rebels.
